\$\$ Old park with mainly permanent vans. Not many powered sites. Quite neat with clean ablution blocks. Owners very friendly. A few kilometres out of town. Handy to have petrol station with cheap fuel

St Helens RA Camp Site & Dump Point

Free - No dogs. Max. 48 hour stop, Dump point and fresh water. Car/caravan wash at \$2 a cycle is just a hundred metres or so down the road.

\$\$ - No dogs Excellent park. All very clean and well maintained. Fantastic facilities. Owners friendly and helpful.

FREE - Dogs OK. Lovely spot. Drop toilet (smells ok and is clean). Quiet and peaceful. BYO everything, including toilet paper! Take your rubbish with you.

FREE Very nice spot. Good sites. Flush toilets clean. BYO toilet paper. Road in is very corrugated, but the spot is worth the journey.

FREE - Dogs OK. Lovely spot. Quiet, but not much grass. Suitable for big rigs. Good roads in for all vehicle types with big private lots amongst the trees. Nice river/lagoon for fishing and swimming.

FREE - Dogs OK. Great free camp for one or several nites. Plenty of room and sheltered spots if windy. Facilities ok given. Fantastic views and beach walks, drives, etc!

FREE This is a small shady camp-site with no facilities and you need to be fully self-sufficient. Opposite a beautiful small bay with great protection from westerlies.

FREE - dogs OK. Self Contained only, Beautiful spot, close to the water. Very inquisitive wildlife (possums in particular). Great beach for a swim or a fish. One area for a big rig, three spots for smaller vans or tents.

\$\$ - Dogs OK. Excellent! Quiet with a glimpse of ocean. Clean, hot showers. On site wine bar and restaurant. Cold beer on the verandah overlooking bay. Good base for Freycinet. Value for money.

\$\$ - Dogs OK. Fabulous spot. Close to everywhere. Great showers. Friendly staff. \$40 for power for 4 adults. Take a walk to the grave and along the headlands. Fabulous. A gate opens out into the main shopping area for an easy walk.

Bicheno Caravan Park

\$\$ - Dogs OK. Nice park, but small - our 23 foot van fitted okay. Would be difficult to get off and on sites if park was full. Not all sites suit a big van. Friendly staff no EFTPOS when we were there cash only. Amenities old and a bit run down but clean. Easy walk to shopping centre.

\$\$\$ - No dogs. This is a great park! Laundry has plenty of washing machines and dryers. Showers are HUGE! BBQs in a great spot, under cover, adjacent to the great little kids playground. There is a bakery, small shop and tavern adjoining to the park. Meals at the tavern were beautiful.
